COOPERATION ON CYBERSECURITY

King Mongkut Institute of Technology Latkrabang yesterday signed an agreement with Group IB, a Russian company dedicated to preventing and investigating high-tech crimes and online fraud, for cooperation in marketing cybersecurity and cyber-intelligence solutions in Thailand.

KMITL's business unit offering IT solution services will become an authorised sales and service partner to provide technical support and training for Group IB's products.

The company will also work with the institute to promote best practices, training and public awareness of cyber-intelligence.

Professor Suchatvee Suwansawat, the institute's president, said this marked the first cooperation between a Thai educational institute with a leading Russian company after Deputy Prime Minister Somkid Jatusripitak's visit to that country in February.
